day.

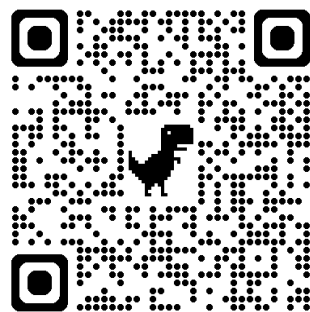
